Parks and Beaches



➤ Childs Park

151 Meredith Center Rd, Meredith.

Playing field, basketball court, playground, and ice skating rink. Public restrooms are available.

➤ Circle Drive Park

1 Circle Drive across from the Meredith Community Center

This small 1 acre partially wooded park provides a peaceful setting for picnics. No public restrooms available.

➤ Waukegan Highlands Community Park

Located off Parade Road, Route 106

190-acre managed forest. Three miles of trails maintained for hiking, jogging, mountain biking, snow shoeing, cross country skiing, and horseback riding. Also includes an interpretive trail. Harts Pond is the centerpiece of the area and once served as Meredith's reservoir. Camping and motorized vehicles prohibited. Park closes at dusk. No public restrooms available.

➤ Swasey Park

Located on High Street off Main Street.

Peaceful 7-acre wooded park, waterfront on the Waukegan Canal, picnic area, and great place to explore nature. No public restrooms available.

➤ Prescott Park

367 Daniel Webster Highway, Route 3 N. Lower Prescott Park.

Basketball court, baseball diamond, softball fields, batting cage, ice-skating rink and skate park. Upper Prescott Park: tennis courts, soccer fields, baseball diamond, walking loop .43miles/lap. Public restrooms are available at both Upper and Lower Prescott Park on a seasonal basis. Parking for upper park located at ILES and ILHS. Park can be accessed by the North and South trails.

BEACH RULES

NO LIFE GUARDS ON DUTY

- Dogs prohibited.
- Alcoholic beverages prohibited.
- Horseplay will not be tolerated.
- Glass containers prohibited.
- Open fires/coals on beach prohibited.
- A responsible person must supervise children at all times.
- Smoking allowed in designated areas only.
- Be responsible and have fun!

Leavitt Beach

Located on Lake Winnepesaukee - 50 Leavitt Park Rd. off Route 25.

Beach, picnic area, barbeque grills, and public canoe/kayak launch. Public restrooms and showers available seasonally.

Parking permit needed

Waukegan Beach

Located on Lake Waukegan - 72 Waukegan Street.

Public boat launch within walking distance. Public restroom and showers available seasonally.

Tennis & Pickleball Courts

Tennis Courts are located at Upper Prescott Park.

There are 6 tennis courts and 12 pickleball courts, two are lit for night use.

TENNIS COURT POLICY:

- Courts are available on a first come, first served basis.
- Parks and Recreation sponsored activities take precedence.
- A schedule of above events /activities will be posted at courts
- Play is restricted to one hour per party, if there are others waiting.
- Park closes at 10pm.
- Skateboards, bikes, roller blades are not permitted on courts.
- Players are responsible for picking up their litter and keeping the courts clean.

Courts close for the season November 1st.

Parking:

Parking for individuals with disabilities available at the courts. All others need to park at the Lower Prescott Park Parking Lot or at the Elementary School Parking Lot and access the courts by the north and south trails.

Hiking maps are available online and at the Meredith Community Center.

Drop-in hours are times open to use the Activity Center (gymnasium) and Game Room at the Community Center. In the Activity Center, patrons can enjoy playing basketball or walking in the gym. Our Game Room has a pool table, a ping pong table, air hockey, video games and more!
